Beautiful Blackbutt timber is used throughout the property along with solid sandstone walls, timber ceiling panels, large glass picture windows and sliding doors.

The lower level is unique and open plan with a slow combustion fire, an abundance of custom made storage and a full bathroom with a monsoon shower. Large timber sliding doors open onto the deck exposing the stunning rock formations and to the water's edge where you can tie your boat, dabble your toes or swim from.

The central spiral stair case is a feature joining the two levels.
